We make chooses that we feel best serve us at the time. We hold our energy at the highest vibration we can. And extend our love with integrity, maintaining what we know to be our truth.

I have learned to step lightly into another's space. Sharing healing knowledge is a wondrous gift. Knowing when and how to communicate this information requires releasing of the ego and a fluid interaction in the moment.
